

Downloading NetLibrary eAudio Books:

NetLibrary eAudio books may be downloaded to and played on your home computer and transferred to a portable listening device (such as an mp3 player) for offline use. They may also be downloaded in the library to a removable storage device such as a USB flash drive and then transferred to a portable listening device.

You can tell an eAudio book is a NetLibrary eAudio book when viewing the in-depth information on an item in the catalog because the system details should mention NetLibrary.



To download the eAudio book, click on [A downloadable audio book accessible through the World Wide Web; click for information](#).


When prompted, enter your library barcode number with no spaces and click Submit form.

NetLibrary should now take you to a page with some details on the book you chose.

At this point, if you have never created a NetLibrary account, you should do so. Go to the top right corner of the web page and click on [Create a Free Account](#)

Fill out the form and click Create Account.

If the account is successfully created, the following message displays:

 Your account has been successfully created

When you have finished creating your account, NetLibrary should automatically return you to the page you were on before.

If you will be downloading to a removable storage device such as a USB flash drive, make sure that the removable device you are planning to use is available on the PC you are using, and make sure it has enough available capacity to accommodate the file size. The file size and estimated download time are given on the screen.

To download the eAudio book, click [Download this eAudiobook](#).

This will take you to a page where you may choose the desired quality. If you plan to transfer the recording to a portable listening device, NetLibrary recommends the CD-quality option.

Choose one and click on the option name.

At this point, if you have not yet actually signed in, NetLibrary will request your username and password.

NetLibrary will then check the item out to you and ask you whether to open or save the item. Choose Save and then use the Save As dialog box to choose where to save the file. On library computers, you may save to either the Desktop or to a USB flash drive. Keep in mind that if the file is saved directly to your USB Flash drive, it will have to be opened in Windows Media Player before it can be played.

Once you click Save, the file will begin downloading and a progress box will be displayed.

When finished, the box will display Download Complete.
